KANE TO FLORIDA COLLEGE ?

In my report of November 2013, I mentioned the arrival on the scene at my "home" congregation Eastside, of a thirteen year old boy named Kane Keleher. In subsequent reports over the last three years I have made mention of the incredible spiritual progress he has made, and I have attached excerpts this report mention I have made to re Kane.

One Sunday this month the Eastside members asked me to investigate the logistics of Kane attending Florida College for four years, and after graduating, returning to Australia to work full time as a preacher.

INITIAL CONTACTS.

I contacted **Robert Harkrider** and **Colly Caldwell** in Florida about Kane, Robert connected me to **Colleen Engel**, who is the <u>international</u>

<u>admissions counselor</u> for Florida College, and she has been incredibly helpful with back and forth emails outlining what is required for Kane to attend Florida College.

I also contacted **Kelly Johnson** from Texas, who worked with me here at Eastside for three months, about two years ago, thus Kelly knows Kane personally, and can attest to Kane's academic, spiritual, and intellectual capacity to succeed at Florida College.

All four of the above people are as excited about the prospect of attending Florida College as we are.

KANE'S ACADEMIC ABILITY.

Kane is a brilliant student, having been the valedictorian of his High School every year he has attended. Each year the Australian Government runs a testing program in Literacy and Numeracy, in order to discover who are the brightest students in each state of Australia.

In 2014 Kane's High School nominated Kane to be their representative, and he was the number one student in Tasmania!

Kane had to attend a ceremony, attended by leading politicians, businessmen etc, and be presented with his award from the Premier of Tasmania.

If any of their members need material for personal study, or to hand out to contacts, they can access what they need from this library. As booklets get taken, this congregation will email me for replacements.
