Dear Elders and brethren

I pray all is well with North beach congregation ,we are all doing well here in Africa it is our winter months now so the weather is allot cooler and more tolerable .I had a small accident and cut my hand and ended up having to go for stitches , but all is healed and fine now .

The brethren are all well in Zimbabwe, my trips in have been uneventful which is always good news. I am continuing with the drought relief distribution as well as the normal preaching and teaching I do at all the congregations. I baptized 2 people in the Sadzagwena area and the churches are all in good standing and are faithful.

The brethren are very grateful and humbled by the help they have received for food, and in allot of cases it's the bag of maize I deliver that is keeping not just them but their family alive ,thank you again for your love and compassion for our brethren here in Africa .

The Botswana work is also moving along well, all the brethren are well, in Botswana too I am still distributing the drought maize to all the brethren. The dire need of brethren in Botswana is not as great as in Zimbabwe, none the less those who are receiving help really need it and are very grateful. The Churches are all well and the many children who also attend the bible studies are always a treat over 300 between the three churches in Botswana.

The Mabalabala work in South Africa is also doing well, only we were very saddened to lose brother Luxon to Liver cancer 2 weeks ago, he had such a quick and short sickness we did not expect such a sudden death only 1 week after his diagnosis. There has been no other changes in the month.

Drought Relief :

I like to keep a strict and transparent record of funds received for the help for drought .I then update all who are evolved .I know that North beach was contributing an extra \$500 per

month paid into my account for food, I had included this amount in my last update of food needs until end August .I have noticed that over the last few months this contribution is no longer happening .I know that each congregation has its own commitments and budget and please understand that I am very grateful for all who have helped our brethren here in Africa, its only for the purpose of maintaining my records and transparency, that I need to know and record if this help is over, and when was the last deposit was made, since I am not online with my bank it takes time for statements to arrive .I will really appreciate your feedback on this.
