Rome, July 12, 2016

Dear brethren in the Lord,

my wife and I hope to find all of you in every godly blessing. We're day by day striving again false teachings and Bible ignorance that make our efforts harder and harder. In spite of our surrounding, we keep our faith and make all that we can in reaching as many lost souls as possible. We hope and pray to find honest people with whom bringing good fruit to God.

PERSONAL NEWS. Thanking God, we're all doing fine. Our granddaughter Alicia is growing fast and healthy along with the other grandson Alessandro.
