My dear and beloved Brethren:

Brethren, The Lord continue pouring His blessing among our congregation, and we are rejoicing for our father heavenly blessings. This month four precious souls obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Back in March 9, I have the privilege to baptize our sister Jessica Carter, in May 1st, I have the honor to baptize her three older children. In this day Bobby 17, Jonathan 15, and Zenon 12, asked to be baptize for the remission of their sins. Bobby is already participating in leading prayers in our worship services. But I have one more good news to tell you about, on Sunday Mat 28th, after our morning service. Jose Olivares ask to be baptize because he want it to become a child of God, because he want it to become the father that his children need, and the husband that, his wife need it him to be. He is 40 years old, and the husband of our sister Idalia Olivares. I have mentioned her in my reports to many times before, I had told you about her struggles to be a faithful Christian, to remained patient in her affliction and to wait in the Lord, but to wait in His time and He will reward her. This past Sunday she was the happies Christian in the planet, she just broke down and cry tears of joy. Please, let's keep this family and our sister Jessica's family in our prayers, my job is not finish, just getting started.

This month and once again my wife and I was able to visit twice with the Pleasant Grove congregation. They had a very good gospel meeting, lots of Christians from other congregations came to worship with them, a good number of non-Christians was also there. Our gospel meeting with Brother Cuauhtemoc Estrada from Saltillo, Coahuila Mexico, was also a very good meeting. He is only 23 years old but he did a great job teaching us God's word. We already spoke about bringing him back next year, if our Lord allow us to do it.

Worship there on Sunday and come back to Dallas Love Field late on Sunday. Please keep us in your prayers, and also in your plans. Let me know if you are able to help in this effort.
