On August 16 and 17 we visited the church of Christ in Chiclayo, this is a large city with 800,000 inhabitants that offers a good opportunity to sow the word of God. On the 16th, the brother Carlos Perez gave the teaching that he had to return to Lima for a medical appointment. On the 17th I visited two families in their homes where I presented Bible lessons. In the evening we met the church where there were some visitors and presented the lesson "The Great Problem of Sin" (Romans 6:23). The church here does not have full-time preacher, Brother Orlando Perez strives to teach after his work hours. The brothers here need a lot of help and Bible teaching. Let us pray that the Lord will send laborers into his vineyard (Luke 10: 2).

The brothers in Chiclayo thanked us for our visit and teaching the word of the Lord.

From the 18th to the 20th of August I worked in the teaching of the word of God with the brothers in the church of Christ in Paita. This church has great influence in the north of Peru, giving support to several churches through its preachers the brothers, Saúl Neira, Sebastián Ayala, Jesus Ayala and the

brother David Guerrero. Brother David is a great worker of the Lord who does an excellent job in this area.

The themes presented in this congregation were: "The Ministry of Reconciliation" (2 Corinthians 5: 18-21). Is God Who Sends People to Hell? (John 3:16). "Seven Steps to Eternal Life" (2 Peter 1: 5-7), "Three Types of Faith" (James 2: 14-26). We had very good attendance each day of meeting. On Sunday morning, a visitor, Juan Loconi, 60, obeyed the gospel and was baptized for the forgiveness of his sins. (Acts 2.38).

At the end of the evening meeting, when we were traveling to Brother David's house, a drunken man hit the vehicle that was carrying us and I was struck with a heavy blow to my left leg. On Monday 21 I traveled to Lima, where I was taken care of by brother Cesar Onofre, a doctor who cured my wound and indicated antibiotics to prevent infection.

On August 21, I met Brother Carlos Perez in Lima. We traveled to Iquitos to teach the word of God from August 22 to 24, to a group of brothers in the Peruvian Amazon. We boarded the plane on the 22nd at 6:30 a.m., a two-hour trip. At the airport, Brother Nemerlo Alvarado, a preacher at the church in Carococha, was waiting for us. From Iquitos, we traveled on a precarious boat for 50 minutes along the Amazonas river, then we walked for an hour by a sand and native vegetation to reach a locomotion that took us to the meeting place, where the brothers waited for us. That evening I gave the teaching "Participating in the Divine Nature" (2 Peter 1: 4). This really was an extreme experience for me. The next day I could not travel to Carococha Island because of the wound on my foot, I stayed in the hotel. When the brothers returned that afternoon, we met at the house of Brother Nemerlo Alvarado in Iquitos to preach to some neighbors. I introduced the theme: "The Great Problem of Sin" (Romans 6:23). The next day we went to visit some brothers in Iquitos and in the afternoon, we met again at the house of Brother Nemerlo to preach to the neighbors who came to hear the teaching of the Word of God. The brothers thanked our visit and were strengthened in their faith.

On the 25th of August, we boarded the plane that would take us to Lima, because at 6 o'clock we had to travel from Lima to Huari (12 hours by bus). Brother Bartolomé Trujillo, the preacher in the church of Christ in that place, was waiting for us. We were with the brothers here until August 28. We were accompanied on this trip by the brothers Ignacio Pajuelo and Jamil Pérez from the Congregation of Puente Piedra.

Huari is a Quechua indigenous reservation that stands on the heights of the Peruvian highlands at 3,300 meters above sea level. The height produces disruptions in health, but we survived. On Saturday I taught the lesson: "The Church, God's Eternal Purpose" (Ephesians 3: 10,11), on Sunday morning we talked about "The Conversion of the Jailer" (Acts 16: 31-33). Brother Carlos Pérez presented edifying biblical lessons, also Brother Ignacio Pajuelo presented a lesson in Quechua.

We were teaching Juan Cano and Alicia his wife, people who listen carefully to the word of God. They accompanied us to the meeting on Sunday and visited us at the hotel to bid us farewell, where

together we prayed to the Lord and pledged to continue studying the word of the Lord. We hope they soon obey the gospel.

The brothers expressed their gratitude for our visit and teaching of the Word of God to strengthen their faith in Christ.

driving hit our transport and I was hit with a serious blow on my left foot. I received medical attention and medicine in a hospital in Lima. I decided to go ahead with the evangelistic work until we finished our mission.

Now I am in Chile, the doctor here believes necessary to open the sector of the blow to remove the dead tissues and to clean to stop the infection. Antibiotics will help as well. Because I am diabetic extreme care is necessary.

Your prayers will be of great help for a speedy recovery.

Plans For The Month Of September.

If God permits, on September 21 I will be traveling to Buenos Aires, Argentina to give a series of Bible lessons for the church of Christ that meets in the Moreno neighborhood, Buenos Aires. This will be days 22 to 24.

Then I will cross the Rio de la Plata to arrive in Montevideo, Uruguay to visit the brothers there from September 26 to October 1. My plans are to join the brothers Aldebar Saravia and Hilda, his wife, and brother Pablo Zazzari. The only faithful Christians in that city, to study the word of God and strengthen their faith. In addition, I am in contact with some brothers who I visited in the past and who have abandoned the Lord. I hope to meet with them to exhort and encourage them to repent and return to communion with God. I ask for your prayers for these plans.

My beloved brothers. I am very grateful for the effort you make to support my work of preaching the gospel in Chile and South America. Our God will reward each one of you for the love you manifest for your kingdom and the propagation of your gospel.
