Fraternal greetings from Chile.

Always praying for all of you, giving thanks to God for your communion in the gospel that allows me to be full time dedicated to the teaching of the Word of God.
I then inform you of my work in preaching the gospel in September 2017.

Work Done The Month Of September Of 2017.

Church of Christ in Limache Chile.

- My work has focused on teaching in the local church this month, presenting the following Bible lessons:
 1. "The Spirit of Sodom and Gomorrah" Jude 1: 7.
 2. "Warming Himself to the Fire of the Enemy" Mark 14:54.
 3. "Spiritual Decline" Revelation 2: 4-5.
 4. "Lack of forgiveness" Matthew 18: 23-35.
 5. "The Blessings of Christ's Ascension" Acts 1: 10-11.
 6. "The Sisters Of The Letter To The Romans" Romans 16: 1-12.
- I also taught lessons about the life of Christ based on the four gospels. We study the following topics:
 1. "Ask about authority" (Matthew 21: 23-27; Mark 11: 27-33; Luke 20: 1-8).
 2. "Question about the payment of the Roman taxes" (Matthew 22: 15-22; Mar. 12: 13-17; Luke 20: 20-26).
 3. "The Sadducees ask about the resurrection" (Matt 22: 23-33, Mark 12: 18-27, Luke 20: 27-39).
 4. "The question concerning the great commandment" (Matthew 22: 34-40; Mark 12: 28-34).
 5. Jesus asks about "the Christ" (Matt 22: 41-46; Mark 12: 35-37; Luke 20: 41-44).
- Brother Rubén Toledo continues to teach the Gospel of John and the Second Epistle of Peter.
- In addition, the brothers Rodrigo Acevedo and Emilio Acevedo Jr., and Nelson Moraga collaborate in the work of the local church, this allows me to carry out the evangelistic work in neighboring countries.

Evangelism.

- We continue traveling to the city of San Felipe, (50 miles north of the city of Limache) for the purpose of presenting Bible lessons to our brother Alejandro Acevedo Marín and Monica Gonzales, his wife, have also joined other people, William Jaimes (suffering from terminal cancer) and Marta Acevedo, his wife, also Helga Fuentes, These people listen





carefully to the word of the Lord. A wide door is opened for the preaching of the gospel in this great city. I ask for your prayers for this work.

- On Monday, at my house, I teach Bible lessons to Jenny Carreño, a Venezuelan who attends congregation meetings. This month comes her husband and children and will join in the study of the word of God, we hope that these efforts bear fruit of obedience.

My Health.

- Unfortunately the accident that I had in Peru brought adverse consequences. The blow I received on the left foot produced a lump that needed surgery, that took me ten days with healing and rest. Thanks to God and the prayers of many brothers, I have recovered.

Travel to Argentina and Uruguay.

- For the aforementioned health problems, it was not possible for me to travel to Argentina and Uruguay, as were my plans to work with some churches in teaching the gospel. Unfortunately, by purchasing cheap tickets it was impossible to recover the \$ 350 of the cost that was lost.
The brothers agreed to carry out this evangelistic work on a new date, perhaps the month of January 2018.

Plans To Travel To Ecuador In November.



I have received several invitations from the brothers in Ecuador to work with them in teaching the Word of God. There are 8 churches in the sector of Ambato, Rio Bamba and Puyo. As it happens everywhere, the brothers become discouraged and fall. Brother Ángel Barreno, an evangelist of the church of Christ in the city of Ambato, tells me that it would be very good to visit them, since special meetings help confirm the brothers' spirit and a great opportunity opens to urge them stand firm in the faith. It is my wish to attend to this call of the brothers in Ecuador, since I feel good in health and with great courage to serve the saints in the teaching of the word of God. The plans are to travel on November 16 and return on December 4. I trust our God will provide everything necessary for this work.

Your prayers are a great support for this work of evangelization.
