Her daughter-in-law and caretaker, Brenda, is having some health issues, and the family is going to have to place Jean in a fulltime nursing facility. A tuff call, but Jean just requires too much attention to keep her at home. Keep the Bullock family in your prayers.

Sister Sandra Dobbs, who placed membership in Aug, has started a teaching job that is running her ragged. Keep her and her son, Denver, in your prayers.

We have some very sad news. We had a special meeting to discuss a request by my son Jon, who as I mentioned back in Apr, had been released from prison after 16yrs. He is a resgistered sex offender by law. His request was to worship with us on Sun. am services. During the discussion one of the original families got mad and left the meeting. The next day they advised us they would no longer be worshipping with. That is a husband and wife and a grown daughter. We are very saddened. Please pray for the Boehm and Urbanek families, as well as the congregation. We gained 3 and then lost 3.

I'm sure the congregation will have to reduce their support, at least beginning next year, since we were already seeing a monthly loss.

About Glenda and me:

Glenda's nephew Cody is with us 4-5 days a week.

Our son, Jonathan, is still working and is able to go to service with us on most Sun evenings. Pray for him. Your prayers for him and us will be greatly appreciated.

My health is good for now.

Glenda has started on the only current medication for her myelofibrosis. She is not currently experiencing any adverse reaction to the medication. We received a grant from a non-profit group that will only require us to pay a \$20/mo insurance co-pay til the end of the year. She has had to receive a total of 3 units of whole blood so far. We really appreciate all the prayers from our Christian family.
