Next, I inform you of my work in the preaching of the gospel in the month of October of 2017.

Work Done The Month Of October 2017.

Church of Christ in Limache Chile.

- My work has focused on teaching in the local church this month, presenting the following Bible lessons:
 1. "The Allegory Of The Vine And The Pompanos" John 15: 1-7
 2. "The Sufficiency Of The Word Of God" Psalm 19: 7-10
 3. "Luminaries in the World" Philippians 2:15,
 4. "Who Are the Children of God?" Romans 8:16.
 5. "Evil heart of disbelief to depart from the living God" Hebrews 3: 12.14.
 6. "Five Destroying Elements" 1 Peter 2: 1
- I also taught lessons about the life of Christ based on the four gospels. We study the theme: "Jesus and His Disciples Observe the Passover" (Matt 26:20, Mark 14: 17-18, Luke 22: 14-18)
- Brother Rubén Toledo continues to teach the Gospel of John and the second Epistle of Peter.
- In addition, the brothers Rodrigo Acevedo and Emilio Acevedo Jr., and Nelson Moraga collaborate in the work of the local church, this allows me to carry out the evangelistic work in other churches in Chile and neighboring countries.

Evangelism

- We continue traveling to the city of San Felipe, (50 miles north of the city of Limache) with the purpose of presenting Bible lessons to our brother Alejandro Acevedo Marín and five other people who listen carefully to the word of the Lord. I request your prayers for this evangelistic work.
- Darwin Calderon and Jenny Carreño, a Venezuelan couple who attends the meetings of the congregation join in the study of the word of God. We hope that the word sown in your hearts of fruits of obedience.

- I also work with a sectarian group (evangelicals) that has asked me to visit them and teach the word of the Lord to them. The reaction to the word of the Lord of these people has been surprising. I hope to find noble hearts where the word of the Lord of fruits of obedience.

Trip To The Church Of Christ In La Serena, Chile.

On October 26 to 29, we traveled with Inés, my wife, to the city of La Serena, (250 miles north of Chile). My purpose was to be with the brothers in the sector of "La Arboleda" where Brother Jaime Varela preaches. We meet with the brothers to teach Bible lessons for three days with the church. Neighbors of the sector were present to hear the word of God. Also, three people who were visiting the congregation and studying the word of God with brother Jaime Varela, decided to obey the gospel and were baptized for the forgiveness of their sins (Acts 2:38) after the Sunday meeting.
