A fraternal greeting for each one of you. I send you the report with some details of the work we do for the Lord Jesus Christ in this area. I am very grateful for the communion that you give me in my work of preaching the gospel.

WORK INFORMATION IN THE CHURCH OF LIMACHE, CHILE. MONTH OF JUNE 2018.

I have presented the following lessons:

- "The Ministry Of Reconciliation" 2 Corinthians 5: 18-21.
 - "The Word of God" Hebrews 4:12.
 - "Receiving the Grace of God in Vano" 2 Corinthians 6: 1.
 - "Heaven, Our Hope and Our Home" Philippians 3:20.
 - "Cast Thy Load upon Jehovah" Psalm 55:22.
 - "Jesus is Lord" Philippians 2: 9-11.
1. Expositive study of the Gospel of John, teaching presented in Thursday classes by Brother Rubén Toledo.
 2. In Sunday classes we continue to learn from the biblical characters. Brother Rodrigo Acevedo presented good lessons about Lot's life.
 3. I keep recording Bible lessons on video every week to send brothers in Chile, Argentina, Peru, Ecuador and Uruguay. The brothers and sisters tell me that these lessons are useful for them, because they can see them on their television, laptops or cell phones. Especially small groups of brothers who meet and can study the word of God together.

I NEED YOUR PRAYERS:

Regarding my health. Medicine and diet have worked very well, I have lost 55 pounds and many discomforts have disappeared. In the last control the doctor proposed to me to perform the operation in October, because for being in winter and in season of the influenza virus, flu and colds, I would be vulnerable to get infected with these winter diseases. So I will continue with

medicine and diet and permanently using a therapist strip, and so perform the surgery in October, God willing.

Occasionally we have to go through difficult times, we went through that. The rains and the wind damaged the roof of the house where we rented and it was necessary to look for another house, where we moved these days. As I told you before, Sister Pia, our daughter-in-law, is affected by systemic lupus erythematosus and we have had very difficult times with her. It was necessary to take her to the clinic many times. Please remember us in your prayers.

BAPTISM.

On Sunday, June 3, Isolina Aguirre, (53 years old) obeyed the Gospel. After attending church meetings for several weeks, Isolina decided to be baptized for the forgiveness of her sins (Acts 2:38). The brothers of the church of Christ in Limache enjoyed the good decision of our sister Isolina.

PREDICATION TRIP TO COLOMBIA.

In March of 2018 I committed myself with some churches in Colombia to visit them and work among them in the teaching of the Word of God. The plan suggested by the brothers is to travel on August 21 to September 10, 2018 and visit the churches of Christ in the following cities: **The Liberator, Villavicencio, Las Acacias, La Fuente de Oro, El Rincon, Piales, Cumbal, Tumaco, Cali, Manizales, Chinchina and Ibagué.**

I have the necessary energy to carry out this preaching trip, my doctor tells me that I can travel. The brothers wait for me, because we will have special meetings every day to study the word of God with the purpose of confirming

the faith and encouragement of the brothers, exhorting them to remain firm in Christ. Your prayers are of great help in this work of evangelization in Colombia.

The expenses of this trip are \$ 2,000.

- Air tickets from Chile - Colombia,
- Air tickets from Bogotá - Cali.
- Air tickets from Bogotá - Piales.

And 1,000 for hotel, meals and expenses of the trip.
