Sister Ely is the niece of bro. Leopoldo Agustin. She is the supporter of Vella Amparo, Imos Cavite Church of Christ which I and bro. Leopoldo Agustin opened the year 1993. Because of her ardent faith she financed the chapel and support the preacher there. She also financed the chapel and lot in Polosahe. But unfortunately when bro.
