Dear brethren, may the peace of our god be with all.

Brethren, my work report in the work for now is brief. For the moment we have suspended the work of evangelizing, for reasons of security, due to the danger that there is in the streets and especially on the roads that take us to each city due to the barricades made by those who protest against the government and many times the police arrest the People who are traveling because they are confused with protester or gangs is another scourge that our nation suffers. The times that I have been able to travel to the city of Granada is because Brother Francisco Martinez, who lives in the city of Masaya, informs me when the road is clear. So, I do not always travel to Granada. the brothers of the church keep the meetings, thanks to God almost all have learned with the training of the Bible, I only through the internet I send studies to some others because of their experience and they know what to teach.

In my house, in Managua, we are meeting most of the members. There are two couples who do not do so because of the anxiety and live quite far away and have transportation problems for the area where they live.

Another limitation is that many of them have lost their jobs, especially the brothers in Granada. The companies and businesses where they work were burned, and others have closed them. Granada is a tourist city and lives on that, not being visited by foreigners, hotels and shops are forced to close and all this also affects the brotherhood. The offerings we had are almost exhausted, we were saving to buy a lot for the local church, but the needs do not wait and we made the decision to help the needy. Personally, I help one or another of my support; the brother who preaches in the city Rama and the brother who preaches in Masaya are also trapped because of the barricades that have besieged the city and can not leave. In Nicaragua we are waiting for the help of the OAS so that it can mediate between the government and the protestants of the civil society, first God soon return peace to our country and we can continue with more tranquility.
