Rome, November 19, 2018

Dear brethren in the Lord,

My wife Antonella and I hope to find each one of you doing fine in every material and spiritual blessing. Once again, we would like to express our true feelings of gratefulness for all you're doing for us, allowing to fully preach the gospel in a difficult city as Rome, world center of human traditionalism and paganism. We will give the best of ourselves to keep on speaking of the gospel, trying to find as many people as possible, willing to know God and obey to His word. We ask your prayers and patience to realize our expectations.

PERSONAL NEWS. With deep sadness I must tell you that November 12, in the morning, my mother Elisabetta passed away, finishing to suffer of all her physical problems. She may now rest with the Lord, in the great hope of the final resurrection. In the last month she went from one hospital to another but finally she ended to struggle. Obviously, she is a big loss for the church here. Along with my father Alessandro, since 1949, she put all her efforts to help the Lord's work. In almost one exact year I lost both of them but I feel blessed to have known the gospel through them. They have been good and lovely parents and we all will miss them so much.

I'm keeping on the weekly individual Bible classes that I have with the young member of the church and with me new contacts.

During mid-week Bible class, I'm still teaching out of Peter's epistles, a solid and basic doctrinal writings.
