My greetings to you and to your family circle in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

As to my work in the past month, 2 souls obeyed the gospel and was baptized.

January 14: Monday, bro. Ely, bro. Alvin, bro. Tebo and me, we went to San Pablo for house to house using bro. Ely's car but unfortunately our target in Sta maria, San Pablo were not there, that is why we decided to move in my target at Jasaan, Sta. Cruz, Laguna. One soul committed for baptism for the next Sunday. We proceed to the sister of bro. Tebo in Pagsanjan and preach to her Family. That was already 7:00 in the evening so we decided to go home in Longos, then early in the morning they moved to manila, while I was alone preaching in Jasaan again.

January 18: I went to Jasaan for preaching and once more, the councilor woman heard me, there were also other family who heard me but dont want any pictures taken. Around 2:00 in the afternoon, I went back home for our Mid-week bible study from 3:00 to 4:30 in the afternoon.

January 19: I went to Gym for body exercise. Then study at home for my next Sunday teaching.

January 20: After Sunday service, I went to Jasaan, together with bro. Alvin and bro. Ely for the baptism of bro. Jeffrey.

January 21: House to house here in Longos but mostly are Roman Catholic fanatic.

January 22: In Paete, door to door but my contact person who will lead me for door to door was busy unexpectedly that's why I just tried to do alone. But usually, they were very busy, so I just returned at home at 1:00 in the afternoon and just study for my next lesson.

January 23 – 24: Heavy rain so I could not go to field, I just stayed at home and study and exercise as well.

January 25: I went to Bicas, Caloocan; Preparation for preaching in Maykawayan bulacan. Around 2:00 in the afternoon, Since I was not there in Longos, bro. Narcing Adelan took over for mid week bible study.

January 26: I went to my cousin in Maykawayan, Bulacan with bro. Ely and bro. Alvin to Josiphine Algaba and preached to her family and friends.

January 27: Sunday Service in Bilibid Prison and I taught the 'Church and its eternal purpose',

January 28: Went to tanauan and looked for cover crop.

February 1: Mid-week bible study.

February 2: Went to Pulosahi Bongabong Oriental Mindoro for preaching. 4:00 in the afternoon, bro. Roy and I, and we went to bro. Nady for bible study.

February 3: Sunday service, where in 60 attendance plus 2 visitors. The same day, in the afternoon we made a door to door preaching and blessing that the wife of brother's backslider were persuaded for baptism. Her husband was restored at the same time.

February 4: I and bro Mario moved to his congregation in Victoria, using his yamaha sniper 150 cc as our service. The same day we moved to boundary to his almost 1 year prospect and symphatizer. 3 heard us on our preaching and the two 2 almost persuaded. Hopefully, they will obey the gospel too. Afternoon, we moved to Calagimay where the family of bro William Manila who heard on my preaching since that the Pulosahi is almost stable now, I want to help once more the Calagimay to stand and become stable too. After lunch we moved to Alcate about 30 kilometer from Calagimay. Bro Bob Augustin and his family heard me on my teaching. Alcate congregation was 'down' because Bro. Bob Augustin and his family is not walking in the faith. He asked me to help them to stand again for the sake of their souls. The same day 4:00 in the afternoon we moved to Bro. Rudy Basilo, which is another who have no stability, which one time I made them active and restored year 1993... But now seems to be like with their previous situation... The couple who heard me on my teaching and once more they invited me to come again and help them spiritually... The distance of Fines Camp to Alcate is about 6 kilometers while Fines to Victoria is about 21 kilometers. The same day, night we moved to sister Edna Agustin for planning to visit San Antonio next day.

February 5: In San Antonio, the Brother in law of Bro. Melchor heard me on my preaching, the fine young lady was persuaded for baptism but her Father opposed. But later on, his being Roman Catholic Fanatic was destroyed when I exposed the great error of Catholic. Hopefully upon coming again, they will obey the gospel too. We moved to another family, a rich family, prospect by sis. Edna. The couple who heard the gospel invite us again to hear more.

February 6: We visited the family of Bro. Derek Dimaunahan, but unfortunately only his son was there and heard me on my teaching for edification, then we proceed to bro. Joel Magallanes, we also went to other members in Lumang Bayan, Naujan, Mindoro.

February 7: Went back home and took a rest.

February 8: Mid-week bible study.

February 9: I preached here in Kalayaan vicinity.

February 10: Sunday Service worship.

February 11: I went to Jasaan and preached to Mr. Niño and to the other 3 families. Mr. Niño was very open minded while the other 3 families were only observing and listening.

February 12: My birthday. A family thanks giving for my birthday. Christianeth, my daughter

treated me and my wife in a certain Restaurant in Pila, Laguna.

February 13: I, together with my daughter Faith returned to Jasaan but Mr. Niño was busy and out of their home, but his wife was there and listen carefully on my preaching it and appreciated it. We moved to another house and two old men heard me and became interested. The uncle was 'Iglesia ni Cristo' while the nephew was 'Jehovah witnesses' listener. In a certain snack house, a woman who's about 30 years old heard me on my preaching and became interested. My target is the Brgy. Chairman, but unfortunately she went away for her job to another barangay. Most of the people there were busy in their field. The people there in Jasaan were all busy for earning money, food by cultivating their farms. But according to them, that place is quiet and peaceful. There is no chapel from any denominations nor Catholic, that's why I told them that it is possible that we will build a chapel there and they were very glad.

February 14: Since there's no prospect to go to, I decided to make a kawayan bed for my visitors.

Regarding to my work in Jasaan, ever since, some people there were trying to discourage me by saying 'most people here don't want to hear the bible.' They usually pad locked their doors whenever they saw a pastors nor preachers! However, I would not retract, instead, I resumed my ardent intention to propagate the gospel there. Hopefully, aside from bro. Jeff, the household of Niño will obey the gospel too. Bro. Lino Villanueva promised me to donate a lot for the church and offered some big trees for the chapel uses and will help or ready to donate for other chapel materials needed.
