Dear Brethren,

Last month I reported the prison had taken me out of the rotation of Sunday preachers but was going to allow me to come every Sunday afternoon. I did this once. Then the next Saturday they switched it to 7:30PM. Even with such a short notice, there were 70 men that showed up for the service. This last week they switched it to 7PM, which means after the last "Amen" in Corrigan I drive 50 miles to Huntsville to preach there. It worked out fine this Sunday, but because they were running chow late, only 25 were able to come. So it goes. One never knows what to expect. But the ones that come realize what they will get in this service - a Biblical worship with the Lord's Supper included and lots of Bible teaching. The Sunday morning services at Estelle are just a circus with no Bible but lots of entertainment. I print out my sermons and hand them out so the men will have the scriptures and be able to go back and study some more. This is one more open door there at the Estelle unit. There is another open door at another unit a little further north near Crockett, but I cannot take on any more. I'm hoping to get some other men helping once they are trained. Brethren, pray this door stays open, and that there will be more workers in the harvest.

I also have taught two times in a new service started over at High Security. My time is the third Wednesday of each month. There are about 10 men who come out of 50 on the wing. I take songbooks and we sing, pray, and have a Bible lesson. It is a short class for the prison - - only one hour. It is a small class in comparison to others, but it is an opportunity, by the grace of God, to teach some new individuals.

My schedule for the week:

Sunday 9:30am class in Corrigan. Observing the scheme of redemption throughout the O.T.

Sunday 10:30am. My sermons are on various topics.

Sunday 5pm. My sermons are going through the Gospel of John

Sunday 7pm. I arrive at Estelle and have a worship service - - repeating the lesson I just did. I get home around 10.

On the 3rd Wednesday. High Security service from 12-1pm

Wednesday 7pm in Corrigan. We continue our study in the scheme of Redemption

- Thurs 7:30-9:30am. I teach the brethren at Estelle helping them be equipped to teach others the truth 10am-12 I teach at the High Security Unit across the street via computer monitor and field what ever questions they may have
 - 7:30pm. We have a Meetup class in Corrigan at the Texas Burger. We have had a few nibbles, but I enjoy having a class with Art Moody where I don't take the lead
- Friday 7:30am-9:30. Back at Estelle,I am teaching Scheme of Redemption to about 23 men, mostly brethren 12-2pm is reserved every other week for individual studies at other prisons.

Friday 8pm. I study with the Hart family in Groveton, members at Corrigan.

My support remains constant and sufficient. I am so thankful to all of you brethren who have chosen to share with me in spreading the gospel in Corrigan and in the Estelle Unit in Huntsville. Together we are sowing the seed, and the Word is making a difference in the lives of many. Please continue to pray for open doors.
