Working for the Lord, including preaching and teaching, is not simply a job from which one "retires," but a way of life we hope to continue for many more years. We are thankful for the opportunities that the Kirkwood congregation has given us to serve: preaching, teaching, meet-ups, etc. We do also still write articles for our website and have other kinds of contact with our African brethren. One specific future hope that we have is, depending on Linda's mother and our own health and strength, to travel again to Africa and spend several weeks there, even several weeks each year. We kept our camper and our car so that we will be able to do this. In order to do this, we will need extra financial help, but will let brethren know of that if/when the time comes.

Linda's mother continues to deteriorate cognitively, although her physical body remains quite strong. We anticipate that it is a matter of a few weeks and she will no longer be allowed to stay where she is. At that time the plan is for her to move into our home. Linda and I have taken some classes to help us cope. Linda's brother, the brethren at Kirkwood, your prayers, and most of all, the Lord Himself will be of good support in her care.
