TWO BAPTISMS:

Meeting with the church in Punta Arenas: On Sunday 12 in the afternoon I met with the brothers in Punta Arenas. To help correct some deficiencies in service, coordinate the meeting and preach about how we should serve the Lord. My trip there was also important since being all the new members in the faith, some problems arose that almost made a sister stop congregating.

El Porvenir: On this third trip to El Porvenir I presented the theme "Where do we go after we die" - After the study was an exchange of questions and answers that arose based on the study and other topics. Many of those who were present are considering the issue of baptism.

EVANGELISM IN ARGENTINA:

On Monday the 13th we undertook the return to our city with my wife Sandra from Punta Arenas (Chile). That day we were dismissed by a heavy snowfall, which almost forced us to stay in that city.

On our return take the opportunity to paste posters on public roads and deliver some treaties by hand in the city of Perito Moreno and Las Heras. In the town of El Calafate, talk to a young man who owns a hostel. This young man congregates in an evangelical sect. I left him to study the Bible course. What does the Bible teach about ...?

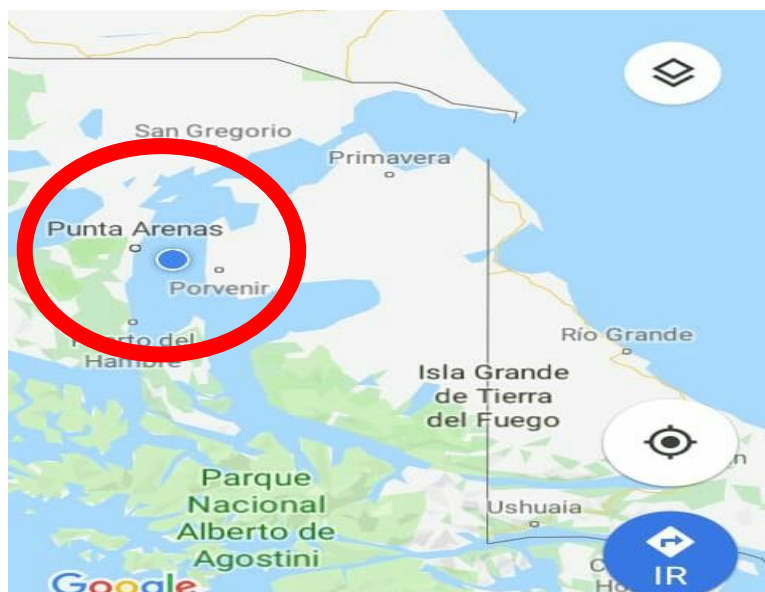
We continue to sow, without fainting, the good seed and urging people to study the Bible. Trusting that one day it will fall into a heart that is in search of the truth.
