Grandparents show kindness in crisis

NEWNHAM resident Jackie Hume usually marks Anzac Day by attending a parade, but as was the case for all Australians, the coronavirus pandemic meant she was forced to find a new way to commemorate in 2020.

Ahead of the day, Mrs Hume baked Anzac biscuits for her neighbours and on the day, she and her husband Barry held a candlelight vigil.

"We had the table set up by the front door with lots of candles and at 6.05am, through the phone we played The Last Post and had our minute's silence," Mrs Hume said. "Most people have been touched in some way... I had an uncle who died and has never been brought back, he was from Beaconsfield."

During the morning, packets of Mrs Hume's Anzac biscuits remained on the table outside her home for neighbours who wanted them. A lack of contact with her grandchildren was one of the hardest changes Mrs Hume said she had to adjust to or Anzac Day.

"We're shut in, normally got to the 11am parade and for 20 years I've taken my grandchildren," she said.
