The means that helps us expeditiously is communication by phone with calls, wasap and text messages.

Given that this pandemic has interfered with the activities of the church, and the time for flexibilization or normalization is becoming very long, and the covid-19 is not stopping in the country, the authorities are taking measures to tighten controls and radicalize Quarantine, for now we do not see the possibility of holding worship meetings and edification and evangelism meetings. For all this, we ask God to help us and planning some way to reach out to the contacts individually to evangelize without breaking the law, and thus also to have Bible classes with the brothers at home. Please help each other in prayer.

So far this newsletter. Let us continue to pray for each other, for all humanity. And let us continue to pray for Venezuela, which leads to a political, economic and social crisis. And especially let us continue to pray for the work of God.
