Report of the evangelistic work, to date.

POMEGRANATE:

We continue to meet, maintaining the recommended care. Evangelism is not being done because of the pandemic. Her friend, who visits us with her two girls, is always arriving on Sundays.

Collaboration with the church in Masatepe:

We are supporting the Church of Christ that meets in Masatepe on Sunday afternoons because in the morning we meet in Granada. Every 15 days, one of the male brothers from Granada travels to Masatepe to help in the preaching work.

Collaboration in the South and Central Caribbean Coast of Nicaragua:

We were in Bluefields and Wawashan bringing financial aid in food and clothing for both congregations since these two congregations were badly hit by the hurricanes.

In Wawashan there were 4 baptisms, the brothers are very excited. The work carried out in these two places was a success. Except that I got sick. I have a severe liver infection. When I returned to Managua, I was hospitalized for a week and I had severe pain in my stomach. I was also diagnosed with water in my lung. I have been treating myself with injections prescribed by the doctor to dissipate the water of the lungs, of which I am already improving a little. I need your prayers, I'm going to have an endoscopy and a colonoscopy, my good brother Juan García is helping me to pay for these exams, for the moment I will stop going out to collaborate with other congregations, I feel very weak and I have no peace with my stomach pain .

On this trip to the Caribbean coast, young Danilo Puerto, a member of the Church in Granada, accompanied me. Getting to do a good job. For the rest, I beg his prayers. May God save us from this outbreak of the virus.
