- **Santo Domingo & Mexico City:** One will come first and then the next one. Again, it all depends on the renewed restrictions and the decisions of the different churches.
- **Teaching Thru Media:** I enjoy working with several platforms among brethren in Spain, Costa Rica, and Nicaragua. However, it does not come close to the personal – face to face – teaching that I have done for some 60 years. Work that many brethren like you continue to make possible.
