With joy I inform you about the work that our gracious God allows us to do in this corner of the world. I am always thanking God in my prayers for all of you, thanking the Lord for the communion that you give me in my work of preaching the gospel in Chile.

Unfortunately, we already have 5 weeks in strict quarantine and this continues we do not know for how long. These restrictions cause many needs in the brotherhood, we are attentive to help the most affected brothers, attending to their physical and spiritual needs. But our God has always shown his goodness to his people.

PLANS TO TRAVEL TO PUNTA ARENAS EXTREME SUR DE CHILE.



I am in permanent contact with the brothers in the city of Punta Arenas. In September 2019, we baptized 6 people in that city, which is 2,132 miles from Lima, (3 hours by plane). Due to the pandemic, I stopped traveling to continue teaching the word of God to these brothers.

They have remained faithful persevering in the doctrine of the Lord all this time of pandemic. I have assisted them by answering their Bible questions and sending videos with Bible studies.

It is my desire to travel the month of July, if God allows it, to be with these my beloved brothers who have had a hard time in this time of pandemic. They have told me of their need for Bibles and hymn books of praise. I have given myself the task of printing a little praise book. I have also managed to buy 15 Bibles. It is my desire to visit these brothers because by studying the word of the Lord we can strengthen their spirits so that they receive new strength.

Dear brothers. Do not stop praying for us, we are always surrounded by dangerous circumstances, but our God will know how to take care of us.

We are always thanking God and glorifying his name for the many kindnesses of him, we also thank each one of you for your prayers and the support that you give us until today.
