Dear brothers and sisters, I want to greet you all, hoping that upon receipt of this letter you are all well enjoying the blessings of our beloved God and the Lord Jesus.

- INFORMATION -

Because of the evil that we have to go through, Covid-19, personal activities were reduced to meeting with brothers only, more than anything as a precaution against contagion, so there is not much to report. I also continue with street evangelism, This is with deliveries of tracts and posting of flyers on the public road inviting people to study by whatsapp or zoom. People are very scared even to receive something in hand, that makes it difficult to explain the purpose of the invitation, but that does not stop me from continuing to do that work.

TWO BAPTISMS IN THE CITY OF RAWSON:

On Saturday, April 3, I went to visit the brothers in the city of Rawson, since due to the pandemic for more than a year I could not go to visit them. My wife Sandra Schmidt and my mother Luisa Mariman accompanied me on this trip. On Sunday I preached in that congregation The importance of the fear of God. On Sunday, April 4, there were two baptisms there, the first was at 1:00 p.m., a 30-year-old man named Jonatham Gigena was baptized, he is the son of Sister Mabel Gonzalez. She and her husband, Jorge Sosa, were talking about the gospel to this man for a long time. After this baptism we returned to the meeting place and there I preached to a 40-year-old man Hugo Daniel Roa, who is the nephew of Brother Hugo Roa. After an extensive Bible study he understood and asked to be baptized at 5:00 p.m. Both men were baptized in the waters of the Chubut River for the forgiveness of their sins.



COMODORO RIVADAVIA: The meetings for the moment and to date are authorized, so we are meeting smoothly. In preaching we take turns with Brother Franco del Arco to teach. The men who attend and collaborate with the service are Edgardo Correa and Luis Figueroa. Thank God to date no brother has been infected with Covid-19, if some relatives but that have already gone well. To date 4 brothers over 60 have received the first dose of the Russian vaccine, they have to wait

another month or two for the second dose. Children under that age cannot yet be vaccinated. We ask for your prayers that the Lord continues to deliver us from this evil.
