As I reported in a previous newsletter, the brothers who had Covid 19, thank God they are all healthy and there have been no new cases of contagion.

THE CHURCH IN MATURIN CENTRO: In the midst of the pandemic, the church is moving forward in good spirits. The brotherhood already manages well the so-called “new normal” generated by the pandemic, while we battle with the “country situation”. Reactivation of home meetings. In this month of May, good things have happened in favor of God's work in downtown Maturín.

A: A PARTNER FOR STREET WORK. Brother Julio Vargas, a faithful Christian, who participates preaching to the church, Julio is a secondary education teacher, and with the work systems in times of pandemic, he has a lot of free time, so he has decided to join me at work street.

B: TRANSPORTATION FOR STREET WORK. Since I do not have my own transportation (automobile) to mobilize myself in street work, Brother Julio Vargas put his automobile at the service of the work. With the support and accompaniment of Brother Julio and with Julio's car as transportation, we have reactivated visits and Bible study meetings in homes with Christians and non-Christians.

C: EVANGELISM AND BUILDING. These home meetings have a dual purpose: 1) Evangelism. The brothers of the house invite their non-Christian neighbors to the meeting in order to evangelize them. 2) Building. In the meetings the brothers are edified and take good courage and strength.

D: BIOSECURITY MEASURES. In these meetings that we are holding in different sectors of the city, we keep the biosecurity measures to protect ourselves from the contagion of Covid 19. The meetings are held in open spaces. Meetings should not exceed ten people. We observe separation with a distance of one and a half meters between people. We use the masks and hand washing. I am very grateful, dear brothers and sisters, for communion with this servant, especially in this difficult time. We pray for each other so that God will protect us all. If God allows, it will be until the next edition, in the meantime, that God continues to bless and protect everyone, goodbye.
