Rome, July 9, 2021

Dear brothers in Him,

my wife Antonella and I hope to find each one of you enjoying the wonderful God's blessings. We'd like to express our deepest feelings of thankfulness for all you're doing in our behalf, giving us the opportunity to announce the gospel also in a pagan city as Rome. Day by day we are surrounded by false spiritual teaching and human traditional philosophy. However, we'll not stop talking about the Truth, hoping to find good people in the midst of such a strong opposition.

PERSONAL NEWS. Always thanking God, we're still doing fine. Our daughter Valeria and her family are doing OK. Alessandro (6), Alice (5) and Samuele (20 months) are doing well and growing fine. To watch and observe them, is a daily blessing for all of us

Our son Paolo is also doing fine. He went back to Venice since the EasyJet Company for whom he works is back to have some international and national flights. The air traffic is not as it used to be, but at least is an encouraging re-opening. We'll see in the immediate future how it will develop.

CORONAVIRUS SITUATION IN ITALY. The COVID situation is much better than in the past and we're rapidly (even too fast!) going toward a "normal" life. A good part of people have been vaccinated and as consequence the general picture is good. We still have a minority of no-vaccine people that protest and refuse to follow the sanitary rules. So, there's a sort of confusing information about it. Anyway, a general attention is still highly demanded, especially considering the new coming "variations" of the primary virus.

We're looking forward to seeing again, after this long lock down time, brother David Thomley (Rolling Hills Church of Christ, TN). August $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ he will visit us, spending some days with us and preaching for the occasion. We'll be really happy to share together our fellowship and long friendship in this preaching effort.

I close now, hoping and praying that we may continue to appreciate more and more all the blessings that we share in Christ.
