

I am always receiving invitations from brothers from neighboring countries, who ask me to teach the word of God through the ZOOM platform.

On Mondays I have made a commitment with the brothers of a church in Quito, Ecuador to teach 1 Thessalonians.

I have also preached this month for the church in Ibagué, Colombia and a church in Mexico, and on church platforms in Chile.

There is always a lot to do when we put ourselves at the service of the Lord to build up the saints.



In the Limache church I am teaching lessons from 2 Thessalonians.

- "Resisting in difficult days" 2 Thessalonians 1:3,4.
- "The great day that is coming" 2 Thessalonians 1:7-12.
- "The apostasy will come" 2 Thessalonians 2:1-3.
- "The man of sin" 2 Thessalonians 2:1-3.

On Wednesdays he taught lessons on marriage, a cycle of 7 lessons.

On Fridays, various topics of interest for a group of brothers who come to study at my house.

We also have church meetings on Sunday mornings and afternoons, Tuesdays, and Thursdays.

For his part, brother Rubén Toledo teaches lessons from the letter to the Romans and a cycle of studies on the local church, addressing the topic: "The duty to offer."

We have the collaboration in the work of the church of the brothers Rodrigo Acevedo, Nelson Moraga and Antony Jaimes.



For our evangelistic work in the city park on Saturdays, we are publishing literature to continue making the existence of the church of Christ present to the people of our city. There we are handing out brochures with Biblical teaching. Although this month we were hampered by some illnesses (flu) that prevented us from going out to evangelize.



The preaching trip that I had scheduled to visit some churches in the south of Chile was hampered by the torrential rains that have fallen in our country and have caused rivers to overflow and block roads. Thank God no brothers were affected.

We will resume the plans in the following months to visit the churches in Talca, Loncoche and Niebla, all this, if God allows it.



Future plans.

If God allows it, I would like to travel to Venezuela to visit some churches with which I have contact with his preachers.

The brothers Nino Estévez and José Díaz de Barinas. Jesús Marsella from Puerto la Cruz. Luis Rojas and Luis Perozo from Barquisimeto. And other faithful preachers who have invited me to visit them.

Also 14 brothers from the church in Limache are Venezuelan migrants, 10 of them I taught the gospel, and they obeyed the truth to be saved. The purpose of this trip is to visit some of the relatives of the brothers and contact them with brothers of the Church of Christ.

As always, I will need the generosity and benevolence of my brothers and churches to carry out this three-week preaching trip.

The cost of the trip is approximately \$2,800 dollars. Air tickets \$1,350 and transportation, lodging and food expenses \$1,450. We will cover many miles visiting the churches.

Your prayers will be of great help in carrying out these preaching plans.
