NEWS FROM ROME (Italy)

Rome, July 11, 2023

Dear brethren in Him,

my wife Antonella and I hope to find all of you doing fine, in good spiritual and physical health. We would like to express our deep thankfulness for all that you're doing in supporting us, to give us the privilege to make possible our preaching of the gospel also here in Rome, a difficult field so much impregnated by human paganism and false religious traditionalism; we are surrounded by all this day by day that often we feel helpless. In such a moment, more than ever, we trust in the power of the Word, able to modify wrong convictions giving a new hope of a better life. For this we keep on going on and on trying to do our best in reaching as many as possible, and bringing them to the Lord's message.

PERSONAL NEWS. We're doing fine. We recently made our regular medical check and tests, and all is going properly. Our daughter Valeria and her family are also doing well. Our three grandchildren (Alessandro 8 1/2 years, Alice 7, Samuele 3 1/2) are fine now enjoying the vacation time out of school. We have more time to be around them and this is a real joy for us. They are growing too fast though!

Our son Paolo is also doing very well, real busy with his flight assistant job at Milan with the Easyjet Aircraft Company. These are months in which tourism is crowded and at the top level and you can imagine how heavy is the flight business, after almost three years of pandemic times. Maybe he will be soon back to Rome for few days.

LOCAL PREACHING ACTIVITY. Our local preaching work is busy, trying to work to external and internal needs of it. Sometimes jump up local problems to solve, as in all "normal" churches, but problems also bring maturity in the process of solving them.

We met again as local church to plan the immediate activities and works that must be done at the best of our possibilities. We're defining the detail of next public gospel meeting at the beginning of October, programming the Bible studies and organizing the children's classes.

On Sunday, after the worship, I completed the teaching on the book of Hebrews, and for some Sundays I will speak about "Divorce and second marriages" according the Bible teaching; a very delicate topic especially in the times that we're living in our society, where there is a lot of confusion and liberal thinking.

Our general attendance runs around 45 (including those brethren that still join us at distance through Zoom).
