GOSPEL MEETINGS.

In November we have a series of special meetings planned, with ${f Roy}$ ${f Courtney}$ doing the preaching. Roy is the full time preacher for the Hawksbury congregation in Sydney, in the state of New South Wales.

Roy and his wife Nancye will be living in our "brethren's apartment" downstairs during the two weeks he will be preaching /teaching for Eastside.

BENEVOLENCE BASKETS.

In an effort to fulfill our God given responsibilities as individual Christians to assist needy non - Christians, without using the treasury of the church, we have devised the following system.

Each week, Eastside members who wish to (it is not compulsory) bring an item or items of groceries to Jackie before our Tuesday night Bible class, and she places them in a large washing basket.

When the basket gets to be full, Jackie covers it with coloured "see through" paper, and inserts a card that says, "From members of the Eastside church" (not from the Eastside church) and we take it to the Principle of the school where we meet for worship services.

The Principle chooses a family in the community who is "doing it tough" and presents this basket of groceries to them. We do this four times each year, with the result being God is glorified, and the Eastside church is highly respected in the community.

KANE'S MOTHER'S BIBLE

The mother of Kane Keleher (the young man we are organising to attend four years at Florida College) continues to bring her daughter and autistic son to Jackie's "Sunday School".

She has never had a Bible, and Kane asked the Eastside members what they thought about purchasing one and presenting it to her. Everyone thought it was a great idea, so the members have offered to contribute to the Bible and we will all sign it and present it to her one Sunday morning.

I MISSED WORSHIP!

For the first time ever since I have been a Christian (I think) I was too ill with pneumonia to attend worship services one Sunday this month. The previous Sunday I felt very unwell, but dosed myself up

with medication and struggled through the sermon, but the next week I was too ill to get out of bed. My doctor prescribed very strong anti - biotics and I have recovered.

LESSONS TAUGHT BY ME AT EASTSIDE IN AUGUST.

Most of my Bible class and sermon subjects take several weeks to cover due to the nature of the Eastside members who need constant repetition, detailed explanations, and mutual discussions among brethren re personal applications of Biblical principles in their lives.

Also, I encourage members to ask questions re anything they do not understand or even something that is a side issue to what we are actually studying at the time. Thus it is very rare for me to ever complete a lesson in one Bible class.

<u>Study packs</u>: Ongoing photocopying, stapling, and packaging of these as time permits.

<u>Letterboxing</u>: Jackie and I make every effort to continue this project on a weekly basis, but often a lack of time does not allow this to happen.
