And I want to sent you the Topic which I used in the Bible class.

THE STEPS OF SALVATIONS

The Bible teaches that sin is a transgression of God's law (1john 3:4;)

All people who know the difference between right and wrong have sinned. (Romans 3:23)

Our sins separate us from God.(Isaiah 59:1-2).

The punishment for sins is death (Roman 6:23)

This is the second death which is the lake of fire (Revelation 21:8).

God loves us. He does not want us to be punished for our sins. Therefore He has provided a way for us to be forgiven (John 3:16).

God sent His only begotten Son, buses Christ, to die for our sins. (1john 4:10).

Jesus suffered the punishment which we should have received for our sins (Isaiah 53:4-6).

He did not die for His own sins, for He had none. (2Corinthians 5:21).

He suffered for our sins on the cross so that we can be forgiven (Romans 5:6-8; 1peter 2:24).

In order for us to be forgiven of our sins, and therefore receive eternal life, we must except the salvation which Christ has made possible.

There are five steps which we must take to receive this salvation.

HEAR

- 1. First we must hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The Bible teach that Faith come by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.(Romans 10:17).
- 2. One is not a Christian because his parents are. Faith can not be inherited (Ezekiel 18:20).
- 3.Each person must believe in Jesus Christ for himself. Christianity is a religion of teaching. (Matthew 28:19-20).
- 4. Unless one has heard the Gospel and learned that Jesus Christ died for his sins. Was buried and arose from the dead. He can not be saved.(1 Corinthain 15:1-4).
- 5.,the apostle Paul wrote how then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher.(Romans 10:14).

One must first hear the Gospel before he can believe it.

BELIEVE

- 1. Second, one must believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God.(Matthew 16:16). Jesus said: if you do not believe that i am He, you will die in your sins. (John 8:24).
- 2. The jailor at Philippi asked Paul and Silas, Sir, What must I do to be saved? They told him to Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household. (Acts 16:30-31).
- 3. Jesus also said. he who believes and is Baptized will be saved, but he who does not believe will be condemned. (Mark 16:16).
- 4. One comes to believe in Jesus Christ when he hear the Gospel taught. Faith come only by hearing the word of God.(Romans 10:17).
- 5. This is the reason. It is so important that the Gospel be preached to the whole world.(16:15).

REPENT

- 1. Third, one must repent of his sins in order to be saved. (Acts 17:30-31). Jesus commanded that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beggining at Jerusalem. (Luke 24:47.
- 2. Repentance is a result of being sorry for one' sins (2 Corinthians 7:10). When the Jews on Penticost Day learned from Peter that they had crusified the Son of God, they were cut to the heart. (Acts 2:37).
- 3. They wanted to be forgiven of their sins, so they asked. What shall we do? They were told to repent, and let every one of you be Baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins. (Acts 2:37-38).
- 4. When one repents he turns away from his sins. (1 Thessalonians 1:9).
- 5. He shows he has repented by doing good work. (Matthew 3:8).

CONFESS

- 1. Fourth, One must confess that Jesus is Christ, the Eon of the living God. (Matthew 16:16).
- 2. This great truth is the very foundation upon which the Church of Christ is build (Matthew 16:18; Acts 4:11,12; 1 Corinthians 3:11).
- 3. Jesus said that we must be willing to confess Him before men if we want Him to confess us before the Father .(Matthew(Matthew 10: 32-33).
- 4. The Apostle Paul wrote. But what does it say? The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart' (that is, the word of faith which we preach). That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteouness, and with the mouth confession is made into salvation. (Romans 10:810).
- 5. When Jesus prwached Jesus to the Ethiopian enunuch, the Enunuch, asked, what hinders me from being baptized? Philip told him be could be Baptized if he believe, the Enunuch the confessd, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.(Acts 8:35-38).

We must make this important, yet simple confession also in order to be saved.

BE BAPTIZED

- 1. Faith, One must be Baptized in order to be saved, Jesus said He who believe and is Baptized will be saved. (Mark 16:16).
- 2. Please note the baptism follow belief. One who does not believe the Gospel can not be truly Baptized therefore babies can not be Baptized for they are too young.
- 3. One can not be Baptized who has not truly repent. (Acts 2:38).
- 4. A Baptism is a burial in water. (Romans 6:3-4). (Colossians 2:12)

Therefore, sprinkling and pouring are not proper baptism Baptism is in order to be saved. (Mark 16:16; 1Peter 3:21).

5. One is not saved before he Baptized Baptism is for the remission (forgiveness) of sins.(Acts 2:38).

Just as Jesust said His blood for the remission of sins. (Matthew 26:26).

So we are Baptized in order to receive the remission of sins. In baptism, the sinner'sins are washed away by the Blood of Jesus. (Acts 22:16).

What does one have to do in order to be forgiven of his sins? He must

- 1. Hear the Gospel of Christ
- 2. Believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.
- 3. Repent of all his pass sins.
- 4. Confess that Christ is God'Son
- 5. Be Baptized for the remission of sins. When he does this he added by the Lord to His Church . (Acts 2:41-47).

He is born again.(john 3:3-5: 2Choeianthian5:17).

He is in Christ where all spiritual blessings are to be found. Ephesian 1:3; Galatians 3:26-27). In short he is a Christian (Acts 11:26; 26:28; 1peter 4:16).
