My plans were to travel with Inés, my wife to Peru. We had the tickets bought and everything prepared, but there was a problem. Our son Christian became seriously ill, a digestive hemorrhage caused him to lose 40% of his blood and he

was admitted in a serious condition in the ICU of the Viña del Mar Clinical Hospital. There were 5 days of uncertainty without knowing the origin of the hemorrhages. After the blood transfusion, medicines and medical tests were better. Now he is at home with rest and special care. It was necessary for Ines to stay at home to take care of Christian. New exams are needed because the origin of digestive hemorrhages is not yet discovered.

I asked brother Carlos Pérez de Lima to be my preaching partner, with good will brother Carlos accompanies me in this preaching work in Peru.

Do not stop praying for the health of our son Christian and also for our preaching work in Peru.

My beloved brethren, I feel a deep gratitude for the effort you make to support my preaching work of the gospel in Chile and South America. Our God who sees our effort and love for the gospel will reward that day our work.
