He showed the words on the projector, so that our entire congregation could sing the song together in Spanish. It was moving to hear the familiar song sung in Spanish by a room of primarily non-native speakers, for the purpose of both praising our Lord and building up our brethren.

Earlier this month, Dan preached a sermon from II Corinthians showing the great lengths to which the apostle Paul was willing to go to reach a soul, specifically for Christians who were struggling in their faith. His message really struck me and placed a renewed vigor within me to reach out to some individuals from our number who have fallen away in the time that we have been here. The Lord has also granted me an opportunity to help influence the daughter of one of our older sisters, Sybil. I am hopeful this will bring continued opportunities to share the gospel with Michelle.
