Several have to skip supper to be there, and some afterwards get locked into the day room for 3 hours and get to their bunks around 11pm because the chapel officer gets them back to the wing after 8. I'm finding more and more of these men to be brethren.

Two other Christians I study with, both converted in the prisons.

The First Friday at 11am I study with Jack at the Wynn Unit. Currently in Ephesians. The Third Friday at 1pm with Alan at Polunsky Unit. Currently in Hebrews. He is also doing a study with me through the mail on Revelation.

My support remains unchanged, and I am so very thankful for you brethren who continue to have fellowship with me in spreading the Good News. Together we are sowing the seed and others are getting to hear it for the first time. I'm thankful for those of you who give me encouraging words. Thankful for you who keep praying for open doors!
