RESTART OF THE WORK OF GOD IN VALENCIA, CARABOBO STATE (CENTER OF THE COUNTRY)

At the beginning of the 80s when I was still in the "liberal system" (I had been baptized for forgiveness of sins on July 8, 1979) I started a work in Valencia, in the Nagua Nagua sector, with the baptism of a marriage (July and Dora Coizman), then there were other conversions and the church was growing (at the same time I started another church in San Felipe, Yaracuy State) and was a member of the church in Barquisimeto.

Years later, when we studied and were aware of innovations in the church and non-biblical practices, in Barquisimeto, on May 27, 1989 we separated ourselves from non-biblical practices and the "liberal system." Unfortunately the churches in Valencia and San Felipe did not want to accept the correction and continued with the "system" and broke the communion with us.

New effort in Valencia. In 2003 a group of preachers worked together for a month in Valencia to establish a church faithful to Christ and his sound doctrine, among others: Ronald and Gregory Roark (U.S.A.). Epafrodito Sandoval (Mexico). Luis Perozo, Agriberto Estévez and this server

(Venezuela). There were several baptisms. Brother Agriberto Estévez continued working for two years. Then there was Brother Gustavo Moreno until he went to another place. Unfortunately the work disappeared.
