

My greetings to you and to your loved ones in His divine name.

As to my work in the past four weeks:

June 28: One was baptized in Jasaan, Sta. Cruz.

July 15: Our neighbor named Mario Dichoso who's the leader here in our Purok or Zone (Zone 13) at Longos, he was the leader of drinking of wine! Daily afternoon, there were flooding of wine in his house. He is a good man but fond of vices, like cockfighting, lucky9, and other vices, wine was his daily happiness. Since I arrived here, I continuously shared the word of God to him, he constantly heard the gospel and want to obey but due to his vices and drinking habit, the gospel was rejected. Some people here wants to obey the gospel but he was the great hindrance. In fact, the recent couple who was baptized stopped serving on Sunday service due to his great influence. But God put him into risk, he was hospitalized due to his sickness, I took advantage of it and preach the gospel to him again, I did my best to answer all his arguments and advice him some knowledge in herbal medicine. Blessing that he's finally better now. That's why he joyfully obeyed the gospel and was baptized yesterday. His wife and children also committed for baptism later. They want to see the result first of the life style of brother Mario. Although I explained that the life style of a christian is depend upon a christian capacity to recieve and reject the word of God. [I Pt.2:2] As to the pupil, it depends to the ability to understand. But most important and first of all is their name to be written in the book of life. [Jn 3:1-5, I Pt. 1:22-25, I Pt. 2:1-2, Rev 20:15, Mk. 6:15-16, Acts 2:38, Gal. 3:26-27 and etc.] that our life is uncertain! [Heb. 9:27] but their decision is final. However, they were all happy that their father was finally baptized. According to them, it was the first time their father heard the gospel and was baptized. They are not yet married, and there's also a couple in San Antonio that are not yet, as well as in Jasaan, there are 2 couple. So after this pandemic problem, I'll invite a liscence preacher to solemnized married, for a mass wedding of brethren at Jasaan.

Brother Mario's wife is sure for baptism, ofcourse their children as well, and one big family committed also yesterday evening for baptism. In Longos, Poblacion, the Godfather of the my son, Godsent, also agreed for baptism, upon knowing that there is really one true church during the first century. That this church is the result of the eternal purposed of God in Jesus Christ [Eph 3:10-11] that chirst is the builder of it, the Christ blood purchased it [Acts 20:28] that there is only one body or church in the whole New Testament [Eph. 1:22-23, Eph. 4:4] that this church is the product of the gospel. [Mk. 16:15-16, I Cor. 15:1-4, v.11] knowing that this church was established during the day of pentecost on 33 AD. That 95-100 AD, the New Testament closed and inside of it is the only one church which is the Church of Christ, that the Catholic which was established on 606 AD in Rome by Bonifacio III, Muslim on 725 AD, 1st Protestant on 1530 AD by Martin Luther, then different churches has arised. That all of them were established by man from different places. That's why, Mr. Boy rejected the Muslim and other denomination.
