A while ago, a sister in Christ in Sydney, who has been receiving my monthly booklets for about three years, asked me to send some to a preacher in the church of Christ in Papua New Guinea.

Jackie is my "secretary" who takes them to the Post Office each month for mailing, but beginning from this month there is a change in procedure.

The reason for this change is the Australia Post charges. Any package addressed anywhere outside Australia weighing 0 - 500 grams costs the same (1 gram package same as 500 gram package).

This means that one booklet costs the same to mail as booklet booklets. instead sending one someone SO of to each month. I will now send six booklets (just under 500 them grams) every third month for the same price.
