## NEWS FROM ROME (Italy)

Rome, February 10, 2023

Dear brothers in Christ,

my wife Antonella and I wish to find each one of you doing fine in all material and spiritual blessings. We would like once more to express our sincere feelings of gratefulness for everything that you are making to allow us the preaching of the gospel also in a city as Rome, so badly ruled by Bible ignorance, human traditions, and false teachings. However, we'll be doing what we can to spread out the Word, hoping to reach as many as possible to the Lord. Without your fellowship and efforts, all this would be impossible.

**PERSONAL NEWS.** I'm doing well, thanking God. I'm back to my daily life, even if I must keep regularly controls and medical checks along the year. I'm getting used to such a routine.

Our daughter Valeria and her family are doing just fine. Our three grandchildren (Alessandro 8 years, Alice 6, Samuele 3) are doing pretty good, busy with their school and sport activities. We try to help Valeria in keeping them and share some duties, but it's a great pleasure for us. No complains at all!

Our son Paolo is also doing fine. He's very busy with his job in Milan and things are going well.

**LOCAL PREACHING ACTIVITY.** Our local preaching work is also going fine. We're busy in our schedules and regular teaching programs, trying to do what we can to edify the congregation and maintaining our unity and cohesion. Without such a unity, all our preaching efforts would be useless and vain.

Marco Di Martino is also part of our congregation. The work at Ciampino, that we all started with him some seven years ago, closed definitively. Some internal problems and surely Marco's wife (Alessia) situation made difficult the keeping on of that project. Now they are all back among us, hoping to bring good fruit to the Lord, in this new context.

I'm very much involved in my weekly personal Bible studies program with Maurizio, Michel, Luca, Clelia, Paoliana, Pierpaolo, Amedeo.
