THE SIGNIFICANCE OF CHRIST'S RESURRECTION

INTRODUCTION

A. FUNDAMENTAL FACTS OF CHRISTIANITY.

Christ's death, burial, and resurrection are the facts upon which Christianity rests, and of these three, it is Christ's resurrection that is the cornerstone of New Testament doctrine, and it is the basis for our <u>hope</u> - 1 Cor 15: 1 - 4 & 12 - 19.

Thus, Christ's resurrection formed the "heart" of the apostle's teaching.

B. WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR US ?

Is it simply an event that happened so long ago that it has no relevance to us in our time ?

What difference does it make to us whether He rose from the dead or not ? What are the consequences and significance for He did us because rise dead ? from the

<u>PROVED HE IS</u> THE SON OF GOD

A. <u>DECLARED BEFORE HIS RESURRECTION</u>.

Prior His resurrection there clear indications that He to were was God. the Father had the Son of God acknowledged Jesus as His Son and Jesus had claimed He was the Son of God -Matt 17 : 1 - 8 Jn 5 : 17 - 18 10:36-38. &

B. IT WAS THE ULTIMATE PROOF.

His resurrection was the <u>ultimate</u>, <u>final</u>, <u>conclusive</u> proof that He is the Son of God - Rom 1: 1 - 4.

His miracles only have meaning because of His resurrection. A miracle worker who is now permanently dead is nowhere as significant as a <u>living</u>, <u>resurrected</u> Saviour !

When the Jews asked for a sign, note what Jesus pointed to - Matt 12:38 - 40.

Note the effect that His resurrection had on His disciples - Jn 2: 18 - 22.

C. <u>HIS RESURRECTION HAD BEEN PROPHECIED</u> -PS 16 : 8 - 10.

Thus His disciples were not to reveal Him as the Christ <u>until</u> He had risen - Matt 16:20 & 17:9.

This was because, His sinless life, miracles, death and shed blood, means nothing if He did not triumph over the tomb.

But He did rise from the dead, thus <u>proving</u> He was the Son of God, the Christ ! That is why Peter preached what he did in Acts 2:22 - 36.

<u>MEANS SALVATION</u> <u>IS AVAILABLE TO ALL</u>

A. <u>CONSIDER ROM 5 : 10</u>.

Some misinterpret Rom 5:10 to say that we are reconciled to God through Christ's death, and then if we are so motivated we will emulate the life Christ lived <u>on this earth</u> to the extent we will never fall from grace.

They claim that it is in this way that we are saved by His earthly, fleshly life, when we imitate Him - 1 Cor 11:1 1 Pet 2:21.

The fallacy of this argument is, when we have imitated Christ, we are not saved by that life we have lived, but are still <u>unworthy</u> of salvation - Lk 17:7-10.

We can only ever be saved by the shed blood of Christ through God's <u>grace</u> - **Eph 1 : 7** & 2:8-10.

B. WHAT IS ROM 5: 10 TEACHING ?

Rom 5:10 is referring to the life that Christ <u>now</u> lives, <u>after</u> His death and resurrection, note the context in Rom 4:24-25.

Christ rose from the dead and entered into the <u>presence</u> of God - Heb 9: 22 - 24 & 10: 12.

Under the Old Testament covenant, the High Priest entered the"Holy of Holies" in the tabernacle withblood to make atonement forthe sins of thepeople - Lev 16: 11 - 17Heb 9: 3 - 7.

After His death and resurrection, Christ entered into the spiritual "Holy of Holies", with His <u>own</u> blood, to make atonement for all of <u>us</u> - Heb 9:8-12 & 25 - 26.

C. THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THIS FOR US ?

Because He did rise from the dead, He <u>always lives</u> to make intercession for us, pleading with the Father for our salvation, and arguing the merits of His shed blood as a permanent reason why we should be saved - Heb 7: 23 - 25.

Because He rose from the dead, we have an "Advocate" with the Father (1 Jn 2:1). An Advocate is a lawyer who represents you in court.

Jesus represents us in the "court" of heaven, His defense argument being His own sacrifice on our behalf.

But if He has not risen, He would not be alive to represent 115 make intercession for us, thus we would lost still be in our sins - **1** and Cor 15 : 17 - 18.

He was raised to intercede for us $(Rom \ 8: 34)$, thus we are saved by His life, the life He now lives - Rom 5: 10.

IT MEANS WE WILL BE RESURRECTED

A. <u>A QUESTION EVERYONE THINKS ABOUT</u>.

Mankind has always pondered Job's question, "If a man dies, will he live again?" (Job 14:14) and people fear death for several reasons.

Because of the pain and misery that often goes with it.

Because of the corruption of the body in the grave after it.

Because of the uncertainty of their destiny beyond it.

B. FREEDOM FROM THAT FEAR.

Through His physical death and resurrection, Christ has delivered us from this fear of death - Heb 2: 14 - 15.

Satan had "the power of death", in the sense that death is the directconsequenceof sin, and Satan was thecauseof sinenteringthe world,and he continues totemptpeopletosintoday-Rom 5:12& 6:23Gen 3:1-61Pet 5:8-9.

Because of Christ's death and His resurrection we can have forgiveness of our sins, thus we do not have to fear death - 2 Tim 4:6-8.

C. IF CHRIST HAS NOT RISEN ? - 1 COR 15 : 12 - 19.

1. The apostles preaching and our faith is vain - vs 14.

Their preaching was a waste of breath, and there is no benefit in us today believing that Christ was resurrected.

2. The apostles are false witnesses - vs 15.

It is not a choice between whether the apostles spoke the truth or made a mistake, if Christ has not risen, then the apostles were blatant liars when they claimed to have seen the risen Lord !

3. We are still in our sins - vs 17.

If Christ did not rise, then He also did not enter intothespiritual "Holy of Holies" (by the right handof God) to make atonement forus, He would notbe alive today to make intercession for us -Heb 9: 11 - 12& 7: 23 - 25.

We would not have an Advocate with the Father, thus we would not be, "saved by His life" (that He now lives) - 1 Jn 2 : 1Rom 5 : 10.

4. Those who have died in Christ have perished - vs 18.

All of the departed faithful have lived and died in vain, and are doomed to eternal "midnight". Their bodies have decayed, and their souls have ceased to exist forever.

5. Christians are to be pitied - vs 19.

To deny ourselves (sinful) pleasures of this life because of our hope of a life beyond death, would be pitiful if Christ has not been raised.

It is especially pitiful re those who endure <u>suffering</u> because of their faith. If Christ has not been resurrected, then our lives as Christians are based on a hoax or delusion.

D. CHRIST BECAME THE "FIRST FRUITS".

Christ did rise from the dead and became the "first fruits" of all who die - 1 Cor 15 : 20 - 23.

"First fruits" refers to Lev 23:9-11 re when the first sheaf is offered, with the promise that the rest of the crop would follow.

Christ's resurrection is <u>our guarantee</u> that we <u>too</u> will rise from the dead - 1 Cor 15: 50 - 57 & 6: 14.

IT MEANS WE WILL ALL BE JUDGED

A. JESUS CLAIMED HE WOULD JUDGE ALL PEOPLE.

Before His death, Jesus claimedthat all nations would be gathered beforeHis judgment throne and He wouldjudge all people, and the Holy Spirit (speaking through Paul) affirmed thisto be true - Matt 25: 31 - 46Jn 5:22 & 25 - 29Rom 2: 162 Cor 5: 10.

For Jesus fulfill these claims He would have to live beyond His to dead forever death on the cross, the alternative is that He is and His claims of an imposter. The Holy Spirit's claims (through Paul) are those re Jesus as Judge would be nonsense.

B. GOD (THE FATHER) RAISED JESUS TO BE JUDGE.

The truth is, God raised Jesus from the dead in order for Him to be the Judge of all mankind - Acts 10: 38 - 42.

God was with Him vs 38.

He was put to death vs 39.

God <u>raised Him up</u> vs 40.

Was witnessed after He was resurrected vs 41.

The <u>reason</u> God raised Him is so He could be our judge vs 42.

C. HIS RESURRECTION IS PROOF HE WILL BE JUDGE.

Jesus' resurrection is \underline{proof} thatGodwilljudgeusthroughChrist,becauseGodwouldnothaveraisedan $\underline{imposter}$ - Acts17 : 30 - 31 .

our Judge raised, thus it is He who was ordained be was to not a matter of doubt. His resurrection is the <u>grounds</u> for faith our in Him as our repent and remain Judge, and this should cause to faithful to Him. us

CONCLUSION

A. WE SHOULD MEDITATE ON HIS RESURRECTION DAILY.

The <u>reality</u>, <u>power</u>, and <u>significance</u> of Christ's resurrection must never be allowed to grow dim in our thoughts, and the significance of Christ's resurrection should motivate us to daily <u>faithfulness</u>.

Paul taught a parallel between the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ, and the baptism of a believer into Christ - $Rom \ 6: 3 - 11$.

The believer rises (is resurrected) from the water to, "walk in newness of life", thus the attitude of those who have been, "raised up with Christ" - Col 3:1-10.

This new life here on earth (after our baptism) will find completeness in our resurrection from the grave - 1 Cor 6:14 & 15:54-58.
