Greetings to you and your loved ones. In the first week of March, my support from Fort Worth arrived, and after withdrawing it, I purchased my medicines and some commodities for the month, including 1 1/2 sacks of rice. In the afternoon, my wife and I visited a prospect in Longos. Despite their lack of interest and reluctance to engage with my preaching, I understand their perspective, especially since their pastor did not seem receptive.

On March 3rd, during the Sunday service in Nasaan, we discussed John 15:1-8, emphasizing the importance of bearing fruits as disciples. In the afternoon, a young man on a big bike carelessly crossed my lane, resulting in a collision, he has no helmet, shoes nor license. Although he accepted responsibility, I provided financial assistance worth 3000 pesos for his check-up The front part of my car was damaged and had to be repair and it's worth 2000.

During the second week, I was unable to engage in evangelism as much due to feeling unwell, likely due to the effects of insufficient sleep and increased ferrous sulfate dosage. Despite these challenges, I made efforts to preach house to house whenever possible.

In the third week, I consulted my doctor regarding the side effects of the increased dosage, experiencing stomachaches and LBM. Despite feeling unwell, I continued my preaching responsibilities. However, in the fourth week, I was confined to home due to dizziness and vomiting.

By the fifth week, my condition worsened, but financial constraints prevented hospitalization. Nonetheless, I remained committed to preaching every Sunday. Unfortunately, Brother Lino faced a serious accident, he fell from a jackfruit tree, with his face fell first, resulting in loss of consciousness and paralysis of arm and leg. Please include him into your prayer my dear brother, according to his wife his back of the neck was operated due to his bones become close together. The church gave a little support financially and spiritually during this trying time.

With the support from Fort Worth, I was able to purchase necessary medications worth 7000 and i was also able to pay my debts, an initial payment worth 5,000 to my previous borrowed money which i used to give my children's their education so all in all there's only 10,000 left and i almost done paying it, bringing relief amidst these challenges.

Your constant fellowship and trust have been a source of strength. Although I apologize for not reaching more with the gospel this time, know that you are always in my prayers.
